

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT MIDDLEFIELD LIBRARY

Circulation Volunteer:

Calls patrons about holds. Must interview with the Head of Circulation and will be trained on confidentiality and privacy policies.

Time Commitment: Flexible; 1-2 hours weekly or monthly

East Geauga Friends of the Library Book Sale Volunteer:

Helps with staffing a shift in the book sale room. Help is also needed through out the year to sort donations and place books on the sale shelves.

Time Commitment: 1 shift is approximately 4 hours weekly.

Youth Services Volunteer:

Assists with programs by helping children check in for school age programs and being a helper for the presenter with large programs. May assist in preparing material for crafts or displays.

Time Commitment: 2 hours once per month.

Themed Bags of Books Volunteer:

Assists the Youth Services department by creating bags of 4-5 juvenile books all centered around one theme, which are available for check-out.

Time Commitment: Flexible; 1-2 hours weekly or monthly.

Shelf-Reading Volunteer:

Adopts a section of the library, such as picture books or paperbacks, and assists in keeping that section in alphabetical or numerical order.

Time Commitment: Flexible; 1-2 hours weekly or montly.
