When a minor (under 18 years of age) registers to borrow library materials, a parent or legal guardian also signs, accepting responsibility for borrowed materials. Until a child has reached the age of 18 years, the parent is responsible for selection and fees. The Library provides a wide range of materials representing many points of view. Some parents may consider some printed and audio-visual materials inappropriate for their children. It is not the policy of the Library to decide to which ideas individual children should be exposed, therefore parents need to help their children select materials. Parents may request that a minor child may be limited from borrowing one or more of the following formats: DVDs, video cassettes, video games, audio cassettes, compact discs and other formats as developed and made available. The limit is lifted at the request of the parent or when the child reaches the age of 18 years. Requests to limit juvenile borrowing of selected media are made to the Director.
